VISA INFORMATION

How to apply for a visa -

- Please fill in the attached Visa form and send it by email to NCC at nour-ncc@netgroupdubai.com
- Clear, scanned pages of valid passports should accompany the visa form, and all details on the passport should show clearly.
- The scanned passport pages should **contain & confirm** the requested information in the form.
- Make sure you have filled in all the information and also attached scanned copies of the relevant passport. **Incomplete applications will not be accepted.**
- Those who have registered accompanying persons should fill in the name and relationship in the form and send a separate application and copies of their passport pages along with your form.
- Those who don't have a credit card should directly contact NCC for an alternate payment method.
- Please note that **email** is the **preferred mode** of receiving visa applications.
- If you have a difficulty in sending email, then you can send the application by courier directly to NCC; the mailing address is given below. Please note that this will however take a longer time.
- Those who are sending their information by courier will be responsible for ensuring that it is delivered before 20th September 2007.
- Those sending their applications by courier need to send their application along with clear photocopies of their valid passport pages along with their requests.
- Faxed applications will not be accepted because the photograph and other details do not transmit clearly on fax.

- The deadline for receipt of applications is 20th September 2007.
- Those who could not apply for visa before 20th December 2007 should contact NCC.

Visa Charges:

- Visa Charge @ **USD 100** per visa per person (processed within 3 – 7 working days).
- Visa processing is online, and once issued, a scanned copy of the Visa will be faxed or send to your email address.
- You are requested to keep a copy of your visa with you once arrival through any of the UAE airports.
- No refund will be made under any circumstances once the Visa is processed by the immigration authorities

General information

- Citizens of 31 countries mentioned bellow will be granted visit visa on arrival in the UAE, passport will be stamped with the visit visa as they pass through immigration at any airport in the UAE. The visa will be stamped for 60 days.

Citizens of the following countries do not a require visa to enter Dubai.

- France, Italy, Germany, the Netherlands, Belgium, Luxembourg, Switzerland, Austria, Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Portugal, Ireland, Greece, Finland, Spain, Monaco, Vatican, Iceland, Andorra, San

Marino, Liechtenstein, United States, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Japan, Brunei, Singapore, Malaysia and Hong Kong.

- Except for citizens of the Gulf Cooperation Council who do not require a visa and nationalities automatically entitled to visit visas on entry, all other visitors who wish to visit UAE must obtain a visit visa in advance.
- The date of arrival, flight details, and a photocopy of the first few pages of the passport, which should be valid for at least three months, should be sent for processing the visa.
- Note that the airline may require evidence (e.g. original visa photocopy) before departure that a valid visa awaits you on arrival.

Please note the followings:

- Holders of British Overseas Citizens Passport who do not have the right of abode in the UK do need visas to enter the UAE.
- Citizens of Nigeria, Niger and Bangladesh are not given any kind of entry visa to UAE.
- Israeli passport holders and those who have Israel stamps on their passports are not allowed to enter UAE.
- A security deposit of AED 2000 is payable for female visitors from Libya, Tunisia, Algeria and Morocco. The amount is refundable when the visitor leaves UAE. No deposit is payable for men and children under 18.
- All male and female visitors from Iraq must pay the AED 2000 deposit to be refunded upon the departure of the visitor. No deposit payable for children under 18.
- Ladies under 32 may not be given visa unless they are accompanied by their husbands, fathers or brothers.
- Philippines passport holders arriving from the Philippines need to present the original visa to the immigration authority in the Philippines to allow them to leave the country.
- Tourist Visa
- This special category of visa is available for individual tourists from East and West Europe who are not entitled to be issued with a visa on arrival.
- The tourist visa entitles its holder to a 30-day stay and is non-renewable.
